

Fertilizer Applicator Certification Training

MONDAY, MARCH 9 • 6 – 9 p.m.

Fertilizer certification is required if you apply fertilizer (other than manure) to more than 50 acres of agricultural production grown primarily for sale. Best management practices will be the basis of the training with a focus on fertilizer applications, rate, timing, placement, and source.

This training fulfills Ohio Fertilizer Certification requirements set by the Ohio Dept. of Agriculture.
