Pre-Registration Required. A \$20 registration fee per person includes a set of hand pruners (or folding pruning saw for lefties only) and handouts explaining the pruning process.

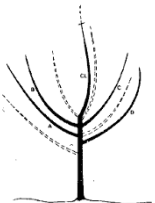
