MGVs and OCVNs have the opportunity to assist with our observations/scouting of tree of heaven in order to find any outbreaks of the Spotted Lanternfly in Columbiana and Mahoning Counties. We had a presentation on June 2nd to learn about the basics. We will provide more information on this project by Mid-June. This will involve locating tree of heaven, marking it, then observing the tree one day per week to see if there are signs of this insect. More details soon.
