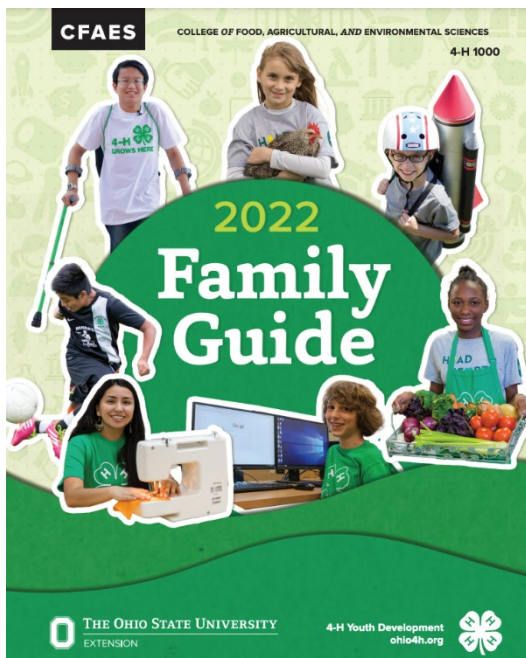

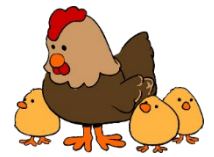

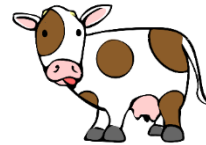


Quality Assurance



•What is Quality Assurance

- Quality Assurance is a Statewide program which gives youth trainings to assure the quality of the product they are raising and producing with their 4-H animal.
- Quality Assurance is a mandate of the Ohio Department of Agriculture. Each youth planning to exhibit Market Livestock - Market Swine, Market Lambs, Market Beef, Feeders, Market Rabbits, Market Poultry & Market, Boer and Dairy Goats (All Dairy Breeds including Nigerian Dwarf & Kinders), Dairy Cattle, Beef Breeding & Sheep Breeding must attend a Mahoning County or a STATE Quality Assurance Training.

Quality Assurance Test Out Guidelines

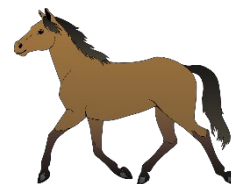
- **Youth must attend the Mahoning County QA or State QA program for at least 3 years before they can take the test out.**
- **Youth ages 12-14 who pass the QA test** can test out of their annual QA program for up to 3 years. *Passing of THIS test only exempts attendance at QA until the member reaches a 4-H age of 15.* At that time, they would take the 15-18 year old test.
- **Youth ages 15-18 years who pass the QA test** can test out of their annual QA program permanently.
- These ages are as of January 1, 2022 – which is a youth's 4-H age.

This year the test will primarily be over the **Good Production Practices 7, 8, and 9** but it will also contain information from all Good Production Practices. We recommend that members *study their 4-H Project Resource Book*, focusing on the Quality Assurance section of the book.

1. Go to <http://v2.4honline.com>
2. Enter your email address (login) and password, then click "Sign In" to open your account


Note: If you do not remember the password associated with your family profile, you can use the "Reset password" function at the bottom of the screen. A temporary password and instructions will be sent to the email address associated with your family account.

If you do not remember the email associated with your family profile, contact your local 4-H office. The 4-H Online Manager can confirm or change the email address in your family profile. If you change the email in your family account you will need to reset your password before logging in.

Remember: Your family profile must be associated with a valid email address. This will be your log-in and you will receive 4-H Online communications at this address. It is also the email address where a password reset will be sent.

Once you have logged in to your family profile, you may review the Member List, add new family Members, and complete 4-H enrollment and registration actions. See page 5 for instructions on adding a new family member to your profile.


