



4-H SAFETY POSTER

Contest Guidelines



- **THEME: “Outdoor Safety”**

- Create a poster on the safety of your favorite outdoor activity. (*examples: playground, sun exposure, water activities, hiking, swimming, walking, playing with pets, camping, and so many more. There are so many possibilities, be creative!!*)

CATEGORIES:

- Cloverbud Division (*ages 5-7 as of 1/1/21*)
- Junior Division (*ages 8-13 as of 1/1/21*)
- Senior Division (*ages 14-18 as of 1/1/21*)
- Group Division (*any 4-H family, club, or small group*)

POSTER DESIGN:

- Posters must be 14” x 22” (*one half the standard poster board*)
- Posters must be designed horizontally.
- Poster can be done in any medium (paint, watercolor, oil, crayon, collage, etc), but no material may project beyond ½” from the poster surface.
- No copyrighted material can be used. (*i.e. Peanuts, Bugs Bunny*)
- Place the following information on the back upper left-hand corner of the poster: entry category, name(s), age(s), phone number, club, and club advisor(s).

POSTER DEADLINE:

- **Thursday, August 19, 2021 by 4:30 p.m. to the Extension Office**

PRIZES:

- First, second, & third place ribbons awarded for each category, except Cloverbuds, who will receive participation ribbons.
- Posters and winners will be able to be viewed by everyone at the Canfield Fair September 1 – 6 in the 4-H Building #25.

PICKING UP POSTERS AND RIBBONS:

- Posters and ribbons can be picked up at the OSU Extension Office after the fair Wednesday, September 8 – Friday, September 17 during regular office hours.
