Good Natured Garden Partners (GNGP) program is a collaboration between OSU Mahoning County Extension and local youth programs in the Mahoning Valley. Youth will team up with trusted and knowledgeable adults to form a 'Growing Team' to tend to an urban garden for the growing season. Growing Teams will be provided some starter materials for their garden, and in addition they can also be sponsored by community organizations.

These teams, comprised of adults and children, are tasked with planting a garden and participating in the Veggies and More Tour events that take place on Monday nights throughout the summer. After all their hard work growing their garden teams will compete for a variety of prizes. At the end of the experience, all participants will be recognized at the end of the year Harvest Party in August.

GNGP Program TO DO Checklist

REGISTER – Submit the GNGP Registration Form by May 31, 2024, to the Extension Office.

ATTEND KICK OFF EVENT - on June 5th, plus two additional Veggies and More Tour events (youth must be present). *Participation in these three events is required to be a partner and receive awards.*

SECURE GARDEN SITE - Find a garden location and inform the Extension Office of size and address.

PLANT – Tend to and care for plants all summer long.

SHOW & TELL - Enter your produce at the annual Harvest Party on Monday, August 19, 2024 at 4:30pm. Location – St. Pat’s Church on Oakhill. A ‘Requirements & Harvest Party Award Categories’ sheet is available for each team.

PROVIDE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT – If not done so already, adults will need to fill out a volunteer form and complete a BCI report to participate and receive awards. Reimbursements are available.

- **Program Kick-Off:** Wednesday June 5th
- **Veggies and More Tour Events:** Mondays, June 10th - August 19th
- **Harvest Party:** Monday, August 19th at 4:30 at St. Pat’s Church on Oak Hill



Other Team Opportunities:

- Participants will receive additional prizes/awards for attending other Veggies and More Tour events between June 10th, and August 19th
- A FREE Soil testing every THREE years for gardens. Bring in a cup of dry soil to our office in early spring for analysis.
