

4-H Member Early Release

In order to improve 4-H member supervision, at 4-H events, where 4-H professionals take responsibility for 4-H members in the absence of the parents, will require **full time participation**, unless there is an authorization signed by the parent or guardian stating who can pick up the child/children. The following is a sample form that you can use to confirm arrangements if you wish to allow a 4-H member to leave early:
