PLANTS TO BRING:

Check your garden for perennials that have re-seeded or need to be divided, shrubs that sucker and have spread and don't forget house plants that perhaps you have grown tired of having.

WHAT TYPE OF PLANTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR EXCHANGE?

- Be sure plant is clean of insects and weeds.
- Invasive plants will not be accepted.
- ID your plant. If you cannot, MGVs' will help.
- Optional, add your name to the label.
- Place your plants in a clean pot or double bag with some original soil left on the roots.

EXCHANGE RULES

1. Sign in with your name and number of items to exchange.
2. First bell – choose one item.
3. Second bell – choose one item.
4. Third bell – choose one item.
5. LAST BELL – everything must go!

BRING ONE, TAKE ONE

Do you love a good trade? How about a handy, recycled item for the garden? The Master Gardener Volunteers have both of these and more planned for you! To participate in the exchange, bring one or more plants with you and label them with the plant name, flower color, expected height, and growing conditions. Plant drop-off will begin at 9:00 a.m., and the first exchange will take place at 10:00 a.m., followed by up to two more exchange rounds depending on plants available.

PLANTS, GARDEN ART, & GARDEN ITEM SALE:

From 10:30 am until 1:30 pm the inside will open for shopping. Plants for sale are sourced from MGVs' gardens and will include natives, shrubs, shade and sun perennials, bulbs and house plants. Master Gardeners will be available to answer your plant questions and help carry your purchases. The garden art sale will include indoor/outdoor decorative items made by MGVs including leaf castings and flowerpots. You will be amazed at the creativity of the Master Gardeners!
