Eligibility:

- All 4-H members age 15 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of current year.
- Currently enrolled in the Mahoning County 4-H Program
- Strong desire to promote 4-H as the Mahoning County 4-H King and Queen

Application Requirements

- Completed Demographic information & Commitment Form
- Completed Royal Court Application

Duties

- Assist with 4-H shows and activities at the 2021 & 2022 Canfield Fair (until crowning the new 4-H Queen and King at the following year's Canfield Fair).
- Promote the Mahoning County 4-H Program at a variety of community events, festivals, and parades throughout the year after being crowned.
- Assist with Mahoning County 4-H events through the following year (Volunteer Banquet, 4-H Kick-Off, Boardman Community Day, etc.).

Important Dates

- Applications due to Mahoning County Extension Office: July 23 by close of business
- Royal Court interviews: Tuesday, August 10, 2021 from 10:00am - 5:00pm by Zoom
 - You will be contacted by Beth Smith to schedule your interview by August 5, 2021:
 - your phone number provided on your application or
 - your email provided on the application
- Royal Court announcements: Tuesday, August 17 via email
 - You will be notified if you have made Royal Court and need to participate in events at the Canfield Fair
- Selection of Mahoning County 4-H Queen and King: Thursday, September 2, 2021 at 2:00pm during the Youth Day Awards and Recognition Ceremony.
 - Attire: Formal dress (no suit jackets, no jeans, no shorts)
 - If selected as Queen or King you should be prepared to assist with other fair events immediately after the close of the Youth Day Awards and Recognition Ceremony and in the coming days.
