  - Computer or phone options
- **Google Hangouts**
  - Video conferencing for 10 people – no time limit
- **Skype**
  - Free version available – holds up to 50 people
- **Facetime**
  - For Apple devices – holds up to 32 people
- **Facebook Video**
  - Uses Facebook Messenger on phone or computer
  - Unlimited participants and minutes
- **Facebook Live**
  - Allows real-time interaction with viewers
  - Participants interact by typing in comments
  - Unlimited participants and minutes

- All animals must be tagged by June 1, 2020
- Once animals are tagged – take pictures and send to [mcjrfairphotos@gmail.com](mailto:mcjrfairphotos@gmail.com) with youth's name and tag number – **Pictures due by June 1, 2020**
  - 5 Pictures needed of animal:
    - Front
    - Rear
    - Left side
    - Right side
    - Picture of ear with tag visible in ear
